Our actions are in line with the most recent government regulations and general decree within the framework of the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic

Breakfast:

During your stay with us we will serve you a set breakfast in the castle hall between **7:30 a.m.** and **10:30 a.m.** You will find order forms for breakfast in your room; please fill one out daily and hand it in to the reception whilst reserving a time slot for your breakfast next morning.

Dinner:

Our restaurant, the "Remise", is open daily between **5:30 p.m**. and **8:30 p.m** for dinner. Please reserve your table for a specific time in advance at the reception.

Please observe the reserved times for breakfast and dinner in order for us to ensure a smooth operation and avoid waiting at the entrance.

When entering the breakfast area or the restaurant wearing a nose and face protection is mandatory. As soon as you are seated at your table, you may ofcourse remove your mask.

We regret that our **Wellness area** and **the Ahnenbar** must remain temporarily closed due to the above mentioned provisions.

In general, we recommend wearing **mouth and nose protection** in enclosed spaces, as it can sometimes be difficult to maintain social distance in corridors and / or on stairs We recommend that on the stairs to keep to the right and make room for those descending if needed.

Please note that the **elevator** in the castle may be used with members of the same household at a time.

A sufficient number disinfection dispensers and stations are available throughout the hotel complex for your use.

Public areas:

Throughout the day, one of our employees will regularly clean and disinfect public areas and toilets.

Your room:

Our housekeepers have prepared and disinfected your room carefully before your arrival.

During your stay, you may want the daily cleaning service to be susupended. If you wish to do so, please advise the reception. On the other hand, housekeepers will only enter your room if you are not present. Please make sure that the green sign "Clean my Room" is placed on the outside doorhandle.
